Because of this, we organize a charity drive annually for our staff and communities managed by AMI, to participate by donating items for those in need. This year, due to the outbreak of Covid-19 and the hardships caused the restrictions in place, we will be working with 3 local food banks to support them in their efforts to provide groceries for those in need within our communities and surrounding neighborhoods.

With help from Life Center (serving the South Metro area), Hope Starts Here Food Bank (serving the East Metro area), Community Food Share (Serving the North Metro area), and residents like you, we can provide items to others who may not be able to purchase them at this time. AMI will be accepting donations of:

NON-PERISHABLE FOOD: Canned and Dry Goods: Unopened and in original packaging with labels; packaging is in good condition (no dents, bulging, or rust); donated no more than 6 months past use-by date.



Canned vegetables (green beans, corn, tomatoes, peas, beans, etc.) canned fruit, canned soup, canned tuna, peanut butter, jelly, dry pinto beans, oatmeal, pancake mix, mac and cheese boxes, flour, sugar, rice, instant mashed potatoes, spices, cooking oil and pasta.

FINANCIALLY: If you would like to donate financially instead, donations can be made by check payable to your choice of food bank: The Life Center, Hope Starts Here Food Bank or Community Food **Share** and mailed C/O AMI P.O Box 370750 Denver, CO 80237
